ADMISSION REQUIREMENTS

In accordance with the South African Nursing Council (SANC) regulations and the standards applicable to all accredited nursing education institutions, the Academy is permitted only one intake per year for each nursing qualification.

The applicant must be in possession of at least a National Senior Certificate with Life Science/Biology as one of the subjects. All Matric / Grade 12 subjects achieved, should have a minimum of level 2. The APS (Admission Point Score) should be 16 or above and does not include Life Orientation.

- ◆ *Must have passed the Pre selection test*
- ◆ *Admission is granted to applicants who meet or exceed these minimum requirements.*
- ◆ *In cases where the number of qualified applicants exceeds the available spaces, selection is guided by the Academy's policies on redress, equity, and educational quality.*

REGISTRATION AS A STUDENT

Registration with Striving Minds Nursing Academy

- ◆ Students register after successfully completing a selection process at this institution

Registration/Enrolment with the South African Nursing Council/other institutions:

CLINICAL PLACEMENT

Students will receive a clinical placement programme after completion of every block, which will present the student with guidelines of meeting required practicals.

The student will be presented with a workbook and procedure manual regarding clinical training, which will be handed in at the Academy during each block, to determine student progress and participation in the learning process.

Students will be required to adhere to the school's Code of Conduct during their Clinical Placement.

CLINICAL LEARNING FACILITIES

- These are institutions such as hospitals and community centres, which have been approved by the South African Nursing Council for training purposes.
- Students must take note that they will be placed in more than one Clinical Facility during their training and that transport to these institutions is their own responsibility.
- Students will have to wear a prescribed uniform when attending clinical training as well as carry a student card and the necessary distinguishing devices.
- The South African Nursing Council prescribes a minimum of 720 hours practical training per year, however the Academy prescribes 1000 hours. **Learners will receive no remuneration (salary) or stipend for practice experience in clinical institutions.**
- On duty /off duty schedule will be determined by Striving Minds Nursing Academy e.g. 07h00 – 19h00/ Day and Night Duties / Mondays to Sundays.
- Students will not be required to go on night duty within the first 6 months of training

FEES

Striving Minds Nursing Academy is a Private Nursing Education Institution and therefore:

- All students are self-funders,
- Striving Minds Nursing Academy does not allocate bursaries to students.

Application and Selection Fee

- A non-refundable application and selection fee for 2026 is R1 500

Tuition Fee

- Tuition fees are determined by the Academy's governing board.
- Tuition fee for 2026 is R71 900.
- 50% of the tuition fee must be paid upon registration.
- Payment arrangements of the remaining 50% must be made with the administrative co-ordinator and the balance to be paid over six (6), months
- Tuition fee includes costs for registration as a student with the South African Nursing Council (SANC) and indemnity cover with the Democratic Nursing Organisation of South Africa (DENOSA).
